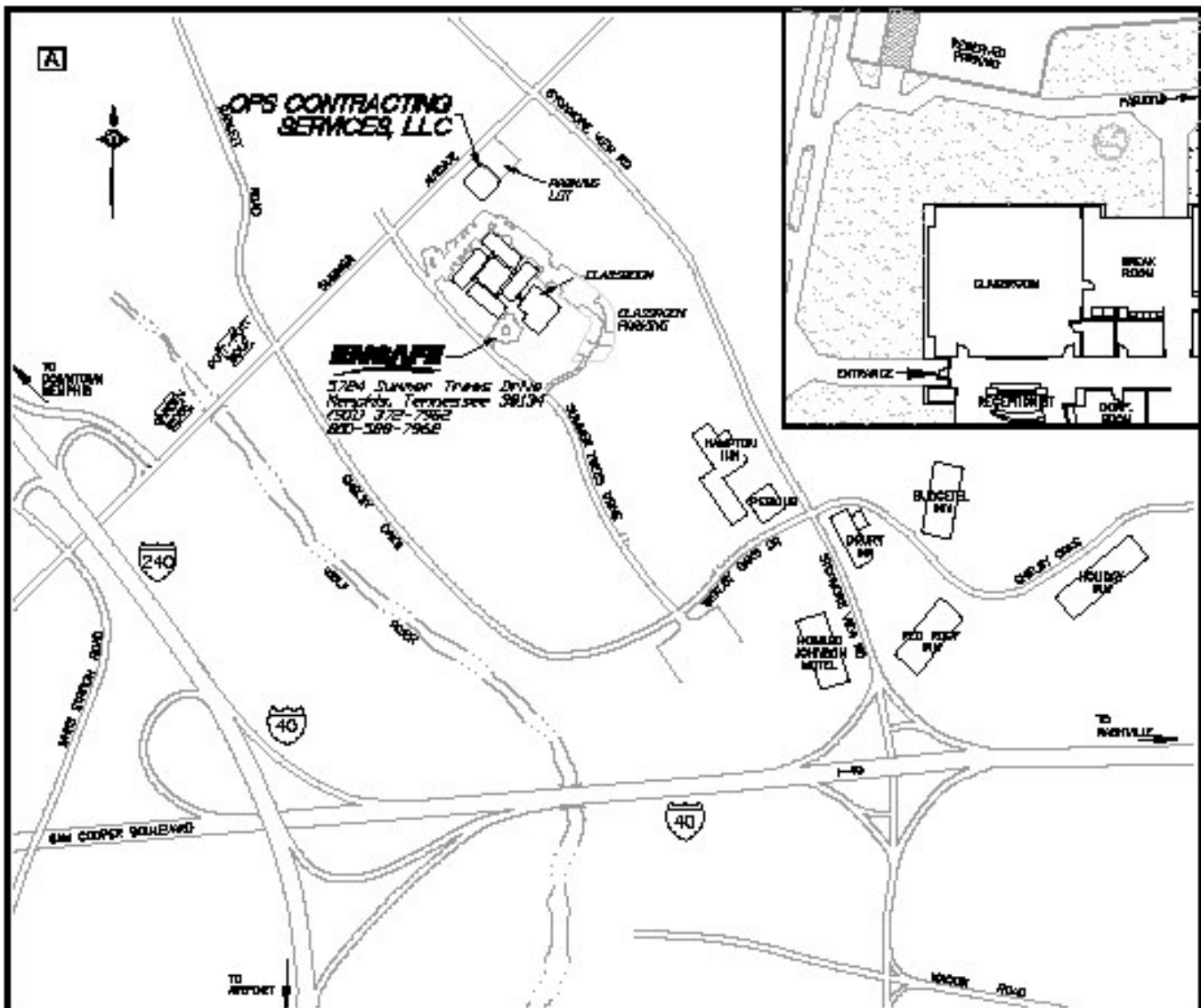

WEST OF MISSISSIPPI RIVER

A. CROSS RIVER ON I-40, FOLLOW I-40/240 NORTH LEG (TO NASHVILLE) EXIT (I-40, EAST) GO TO FIRST EXIT SYCAMORE VIEW RD. (EXIT 12). SEE FIGURE A. TURN LEFT AT LIGHT. SEE NOTE BELOW.

FROM EAST OF MEMPHIS

A. FROM I-40 EXIT AT SYCAMORE VIEW RD. (EXIT 12), TURN RIGHT (NORTH), SEE FIGURE A AND NOTE BELOW.

FROM AIRPORT

- A. OUT OF PARKING LOT, FOLLOW SIGNS TO I-240 EAST. SEE FIGURE B.
- B. PROCEED EAST ON I-240 TO I-40 EAST (TO NASHVILLE). PROCEED EAST (RIGHT) ON I-40 TO FIRST EXIT, SYCAMORE VIEW RD. (EXIT 12), TURN LEFT, SEE FIGURE B, AND NOTE BELOW.

FROM SOUTH OF MEMPHIS

A. FROM I-55 (NORTH) FOLLOW I-240 SOUTH LEG (TO NASHVILLE), SEE FIGURE B AND NOTE BELOW.

NOTE

PROCEED NORTH ON SYCAMORE VIEW RD. TO FIRST STREET (SHELBY DAVIS DR.) TURN LEFT PROCEED WEST ON SHELBY DAVIS DR. TO FIRST STREET ON THE RIGHT (SUMMER TREES DR.) TURN RIGHT ON SUMMER TREES DR. AND PROCEED NORTH TO ENSAFE COMPLEX TURN RIGHT INTO VISITOR PARKING.
